4. The Grant is Subject to the adjustment on the basis of Utilization Certificate in the prescribed proforma submitted by the University/Institution.
5. The University / Institution shall maintain proper accounts of the expenditure out of the Grants which shall be utilized only on the approved items of expenditure.
6. The University / Institution may follow the General Financial Rules, 2017 and take urgent necessary action to amend their manuals of financial procedures to bring them in conformity with GERs, 2017 and those don't have their own approved manuals on financial procedures may adopt the provisions of GFRs, 2017 and instructions/guideline there under from time to time.
7. The Utilization Certificate to the effect that the grant has been utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned shall be furnished to UGC as early as possible after the close of current financial year.
8. This allows a centralized control over operational efficiency, resource utilization to attain overall development of the mentee institution. Hub can also be conceived as a pool of experts from multiple resources. External members can also be solicited from the industry and can be used as a resource pool. They can make a ground assessment and can have a clear action plan for mentoring.

Prospective of MoU:

4. An implementation plan should be developed with clear timeline and schedule for monitoring of progress. Execution of the implementation Plan may include various activities like mentor-mentee meetings, developing strategies, defining goals and deliverables.

1. Training of Faculty and Staff for proper processes, documentation, presentation
2. Sharing of knowledge, information and resources,
3. Opportunities for research collaboration and faculty development
4. Guidance and encouragement to institutions to adopt best practices.

The Benefits to the Mentee Institute:

1. Brings about enhancement in the overall Quality of the Mentee Institution
2. Enhances the profile of institutions as a result of improved quality of Research, Teaching and Learning methodologies.
3. Receives support in the Professional Development of Academics
4. Increased exposure and speedier adaptation to best practices

The Parties have agreed to enter into this Agreement on such Terms & Conditions as are mentioned herein below.

- a) Mentee Institute is responsible to identify the coordinator from their institution.
- b) The Coordinator of the mentee institute shall be acted as single point of contact while in the process of work.
- c) The mentee institution has to undergo the complete accreditation process with the help of mentor institution.
- d) While in the process of execution of this scheme, No expenses will be charged to Mentee institute for the resource persons.

Time-Line:

This MoU, unless extended by mutual written consent of the institutes, shall expire in one year after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. However, on review, the MoU shall be extended for another one year period by mutual consent.




